

## Detailed Program Costs and Payment Schedules Aix-en-Provence 2012 - 2013

### PROGRAM COSTS

Costs include tuition, book fees, housing and meals (*demi-pension* – seven breakfasts & five dinners a week plus Sunday lunches), scheduled activities and excursions, comprehensive health & personal liability insurance\*, and one optional course at the *Institut d'Etudes Politiques* or, in the framework of "AUCP Direct," three optional courses at the University of Aix\*\* (Full-Year & Spring only). Airfare and local daily transport are not included.

#### \*Health & Personal Liability Insurance

Coverage limited to the Study Period (see AUCP calendar) plus maximum travel time of 3 days prior to and following the Study Period. For coverage beyond these limits (for pre- or post-semester travel), the student must take out his/her own insurance.

#### \*\*Optional Courses at the *Institut d'Etudes Politiques (IEP)*/ University of Aix

- French Language Requirement: TEF Certified Advanced French (Level 5 CEFR C1)
- Courses at the IEP can be completed during the regular AUCP semester.
- Courses at the University of Aix may require that the student be present for the first 3 weeks of January (for Fall Semester) and/or until the end of May (for Spring Semester) for final exams. In this case, a supplementary housing fee of 20 € (Euros) per night will be charged for the extended stay.

#### Withdrawals

For notification received thirty days or fewer before the established Saturday arrival date for the onset of the semester: 100% of tuition and fees are reimbursed to the student and/or paying institution, minus the \$500 deposit and a \$200 administrative fee.

For notification received fifteen days or fewer before the established Saturday arrival date for the onset of the semester: 100% of tuition and fees are reimbursed to the student and/or paying institution, minus the \$500 deposit and \$1000, in the form of an \$800 penalty and a \$200 administrative fee.

### PROGRAM COSTS

Costs include tuition, book fees, housing and meals (*demi-pension* – seven breakfasts & five dinners a week plus Sunday lunches), scheduled activities and excursions, comprehensive health & personal liability insurance,\* and the one-week on-site study in North Africa. Airfare and local daily transport are not included, with the exception of the round trip flight for the study tour in North Africa\*\*.

#### \*Health & Personal Liability Insurance

Coverage limited to the Study Period (see AUCP calendar) plus maximum travel time of 3 days prior to and following the Study Period. For coverage beyond these limits (for pre- or post-semester travel), the student must take out his/her own insurance.

#### \*\*Visa Fee for Study Tour in North Africa

Non-U.S. and European citizens may need a visa for Morocco. This can be applied for while on-site in France. A supplementary fee of about 20€ will be required.

#### Withdrawals

For notification received thirty days or fewer before the established Saturday arrival date for the onset of the semester: 100% of tuition and fees are reimbursed to the student and/or paying institution, minus the \$500 deposit and a \$200 administrative fee

For notification received fifteen days or fewer before the established Saturday arrival date for the onset of the semester: 100% of tuition and fees are reimbursed to the student and/or paying institution, minus the \$500 deposit and \$1000, in the form of an \$800 penalty and a \$200 administrative fee.

### PROGRAM COSTS

Costs include tuition, housing in carefully selected French families on a *demi-pension* basis (seven breakfasts and five dinners a week plus Sunday lunches), comprehensive health and personal liability insurance\*, book fees, and four full-day field trips. Airfare and local daily transport are not included.

For notification received fifteen days or fewer before the established Saturday arrival date for the onset of the session: 100% of tuition and fees are reimbursed to the student and/or paying institution, minus the \$500 deposit and \$700, in the form of a \$500 penalty and a \$200 administrative fee.
