

## Guidelines AUCP Representatives

As an AUCP alum, you are particularly well-placed to inform and guide prospective students in their program choice. Here are a few guidelines that will go beyond just your sharing of your individual experience, in order of priority.

### Level of French

The first thing to address is the AUCP entry-level French requirement:

**4 college semesters or an equivalent high-intermediate level.**

Please note that we now have an **intensive summer program** from mid-June to mid-July that allows students to complete one semester (3 credits) or two semesters (6 credits) of French in this one four-week term. Please refer to the Summer flyer and the AUCP website for details.

### Areas of Interest

If they have or will have the French level by the time they apply, ask students their major and orient Aix or Marseille accordingly.

### Immersion

Call attention to the integration strategies that bring meaning to our catch phrase *Living with and Like the French*

- Individual Homestay
- Community Service
- Club membership
- Language Partner
- All French speaking contract (Even if you did not respect this 100%, pretend that you did and be encouraging!)

### Course work

Talk about the classes you liked and emphasize that they were **taught in French**.

### French university enrollment (for Aix only)

Students with a C1 level on the TEF may take one or two classes at the Université de Provence, any class they wish. The restriction is that Fall students will be taking their final exam in mid to late January, and Spring students in mid to late June. Unless students have that flexibility, the option will be mostly enjoyed by Full Year students.

### Marseille's NEW Fall Program

Please mention this for those with appropriate majors. The course in **NGO's** should be of particular interest. Please check it out on the website before the fair.
